OVERVIEW

India ranks 76 out of 168 countries in the Corruption Perception Index for the year 2015 , as per the Transparency International report, with a score of 38 for corruption in public sector undertakings on a scale of 0 (highly corrupt) and 100 (very clean).

Corruption is a considerable obstacle to economic and social development around the world. It has a negative impact on sustainable development. However, it remains widespread in the country and there have been many instances of political, bureaucratic corruption, corporate frauds, public funds embezzlement, fraudulent procurement practices and judicial corruption. The government has put in place a well developed legal and institutional framework, with institutions including the Central Bureau of Investigation, the Office of the Comptroller and the Auditor General, and the Central Vigilance Commission. The Supreme Court has taken a firm stance against corruption in recent years and made several important rulings. Another achievement has been the enactment of the Right to Information (RTI) Act in 2005, which grants citizens access to government information and a mechanism to control public spending. In spite of this progress, the law enforcement and reforms have a long way to go.

INTRODUCTION

Recognizing that corruption is a most significant roadblock in the improved governance,. Development and progress of our country, the Anti-Corruption Academy (ACA) aims to become the beacon that will guide the country and its citizens towards a culture and practice of integrity and accountability.

The need for such a pioneering institution is not only in India, but also in Asia and all the continents. The ACA will produce, manage and disseminate anti-corruption knowledge, good practice and all tools necessary for the construction and effective implementation of measures and policies in a systematic and inclusive way.
